#### Plain Text, as Enacted:


- Title: Actions Involving the Exercise of Certain <u>Constitutional</u> Rights
- Purpose: Encourage and safeguard the <u>constitutional</u> rights of persons to petition, speak freely, associate freely, and otherwise participate in government

# **Unexpected Scope**



#### **Seven Years Later:**

- Just because "the TCPA professes to safeguard the exercise of certain First Amendment rights" does <u>not</u> mean "it should only apply to <u>constitutionally</u> guaranteed activities."
