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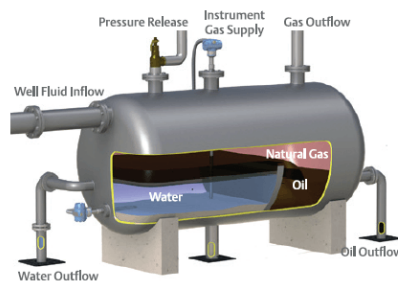
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Oil and Gas Wastewater Management

Typical Separator

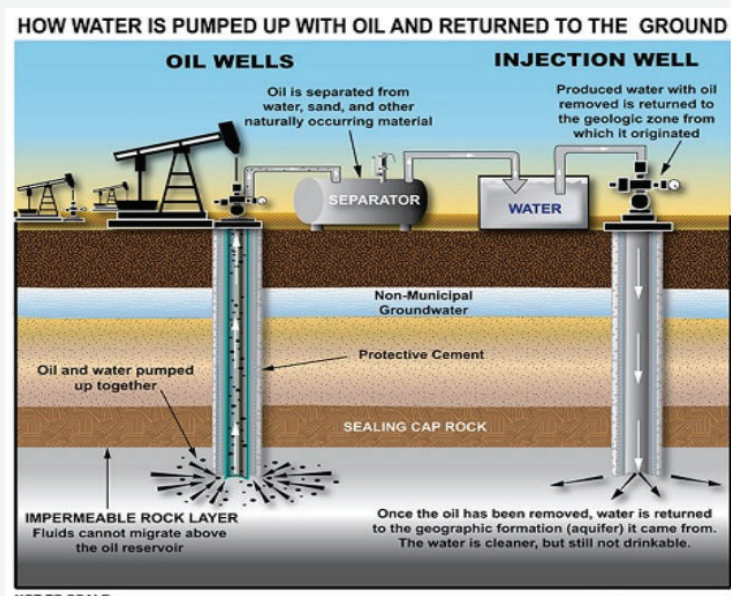
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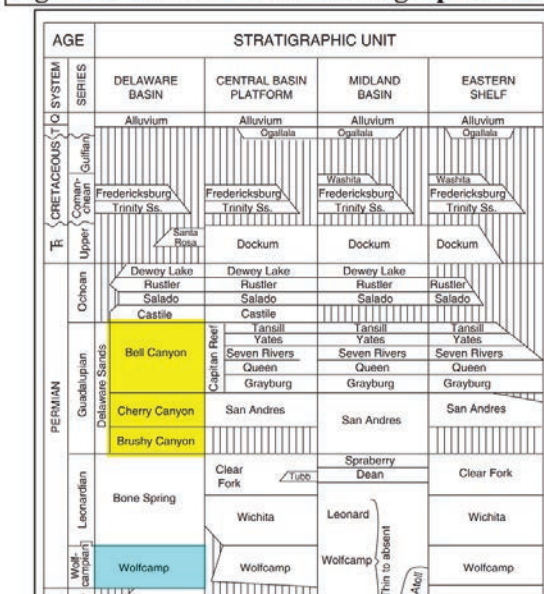


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Figure 5. Permian Basin Stratigraphic Column.



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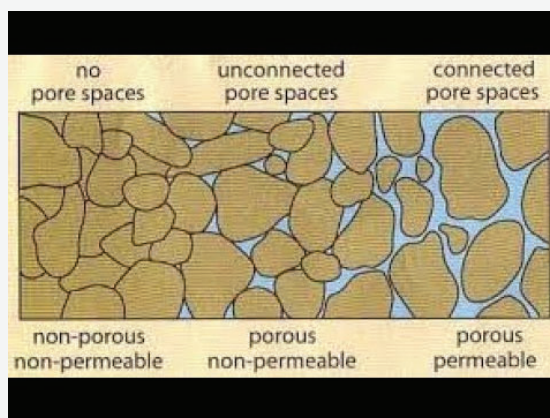
