---

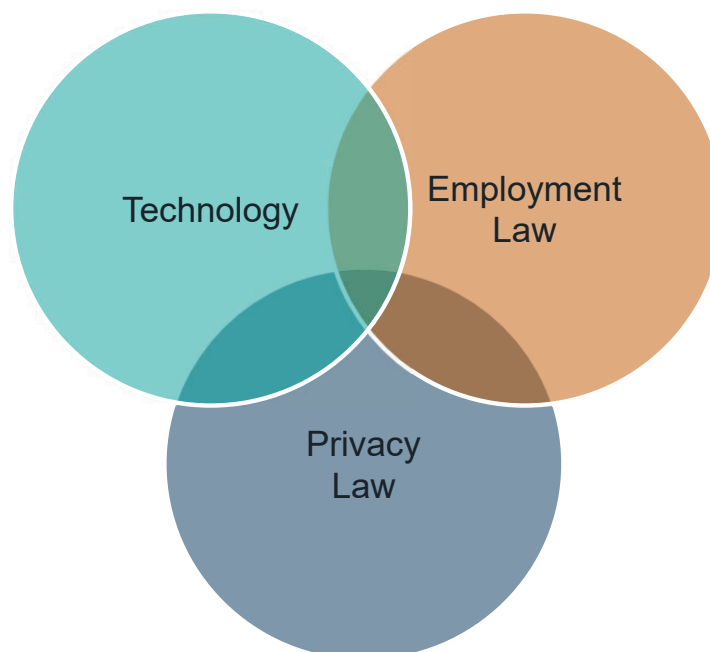
- Corporate network usage

## Real-time Screen Monitoring

Whenever you want to check what your employees are doing, you can use real-time screen monitoring. You can easily see the world through your employees' eyes.

## Watch Multiple Screens Simultaneous

SurveilStar allows you to watch multiple screens simultaneous, 2\*2, 3\*3 and 4\*4 are supported. You can monitor up to 16 screens at the same time.

## Record Screenshots for Future Review

By default, SurveilStar doesn't take screen snapshots. However, you can create a Screen Monitoring policy to record screen snapshots and you can replay it like a video later. Default interval is 15 seconds, and it's up to you to set more or less frequently.

## Export as Picture or Video

You can save the real-time screenshot as individual \*.jpg or \*.bmp picture, or export the recorded snapshots as \*.wmv video file.
