


Needs Based Benefits

- Supplemental Security Income (SSI)
- Medicaid
- Food stamps, legal aid, and utility payment assistance
- Housing subsidies (H.U.D. or Section 8)

Entitlement Benefits

- Social Security Disability Insurance • (SSDI)
- Childhood Disability Benefits (CDB)
- Medicare
- **Special Education**





Supplemental Security Income

SSI is intended to pay for the beneficiary's food and shelter.

Supplemental Security Income

- The SSI rate for 2022:
 - \$841 for an individual
 - \$1,261 for a couple
- Some states supplement SSI, so recipients may get a higher amount
