# Healthcare Reform Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (PPACA)

- Increase in the number of plans
  - Only two states with a single plan; CVS Aetna back in
- 4% average decline in premium in 2020
- New enrollment period
- Withdrawal of federal government opposition
- 14.5 million enrollees
