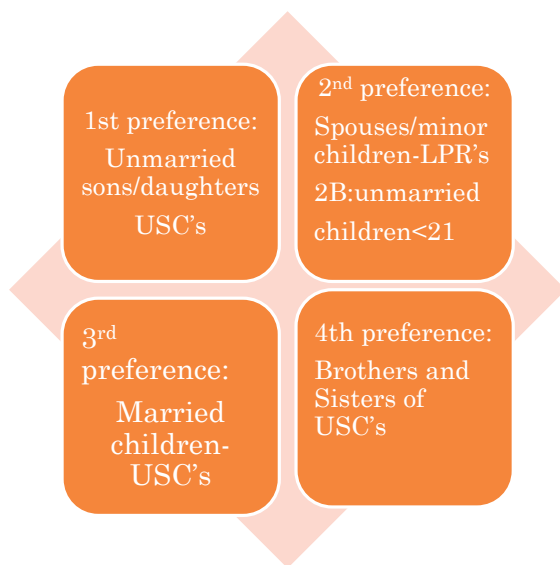

PRIORITY DATES

Priority dates are assigned to each application based on the date that the application was received by the USCIS
