Why Business Entities

- *An ingenious device for obtaining profit without individual responsibility.* - Ambrose Bierce

Three purposes

- **Capital Aggregation**
- **Limited Liability**
- **Tax**

Why Business Entities

Legal Fiction

- **Can own, buy, or sell property in its own name, enter into contracts, borrow money**
- **Right to sue and be sued for civil wrongs**

Tort - Responsible for acts of employees – vicarious liability/respondeat superior (car accidents)

Breach of Contract

Discrimination

- Has free speech (per the US Supreme Court)
- Can be criminally responsible but limited to financial penalties

Business Entities

- **Sole Proprietorship**
- **Partnership**
 - General Ps and Limited Ps
- **Limited Liability Company (LLC)**
- **Corporation**
 - S-Corp

Sole Proprietorship

- **One individual**
 - May use a DBA – assumed name
- **No liability protection**
- **Taxed at personal rate**
