Rule 910.3 (b)

Existing causes of action. The requirements of this part do not apply where a cause of action related to a noncompete clause accrued prior to the effective date.

2. Is the non-compete part of an agreement to sell a business?

Rule 910.3 (a)

Bona fide sales of business. The requirements of this part shall not apply to a non-compete clause that is entered into by a person pursuant to a bona fide sale of a business entity, of the person's ownership interest in a business entity, or of all or substantially all of a business entity's operating assets.
