


Commission For Lawyer Discipline

- ► Permanent committee of the State Bar
- Made up of 12 members
 - 6 attorneys & 6 public members
 - Appointed by the State Bar President and the Supreme Court of Texas
- CFLD is the party and client in CDC actions

Chief Disciplinary Counsel

- ► Administers the Disciplinary System
- ► Represents CFLD
- Performs other duties relating to disciplinary matters as assigned by CFLD

Grievance Committees

- Members are nominated by Bar Director(s) for their district and appointed by State Bar President
 - 2/3 attorneys; 1/3 public
- Act through panels assigned by Committee Chair
- Conduct:
 - Summary Disposition Panel Dockets
 - Administrative Evidentiary Hearings
 - Investigatory Hearings
