
• <u>What is the EOIR Courts & Appeals System (ECAS)?</u> • ECAS was first introduced in July 2018 to phase **Overview of** out paper filing and processing, and to retain all records and case-related documents in electronic ECAS format. Now fully implemented at all immigration courts and the Board of Immigration Appeals (BIA), ECAS supports the full life cycle of an immigration case including: electronic filing of court and appeals documents, processing and receiving filings, maintaining electronic Records of Proceedings (eROPs), preparing case information, conducting a hearing, and adjudicating appeals, while providing cost and time savings for all parties.

What is a Case Portal?

- It's like an open electronic file with access to all the documents filed through ECAS and court documents.
- Divided by Bond Hearing and Removal Proceedings (you can't access EROP for Bond if your E-28 does not include both proceedings & vice-versa)

How do I register to practice in EOIR immigration courts or before the Board of Immigration Appeals?

- Register online
- Register as an individual (cannot register as a firm)
- You will have to do an ID validation process w/in 90 days
- Partial accreditation reps/law students/your nice neighbor CANNOT register at this time.
