HISTORY

- 2015 chancery court bill (HB 1603) that was voted out of committee (but failed to pass in the House)
- 2017 chancery court bill (HB 2594) that was filed but never voted out of committee
- 2019 business courts bill (HB 4149) that was filed but never voted out of committee
- 2021 business courts bill (HB 1875) that was voted out of committee (but failed to pass in the House)

all cases or any matters arising out of or related to a civil case brought by or against the state or a state agency, board, or commission or by or against an officer of the state or a state agency, board, or commission.
