

IMMIGRATION HAS BECOME ONE THE MOST IMPORTANT AND MOST POLARIZING ISSUE FACING AMERICA






What is Fueling the Immigration Fire?

- ▶8 years of relentless demonization & disinformation
- ➤ Non-stop media coverage
- Political Gamesmanship
 - · Chaos caused by busing migrants to Democratic cities
 - Congress is unwilling to legislate & Executive authority is limited (and challenged in court)
- ➤ Biden administration's delay in tackling it head-on
 - 70% disapproval of President Biden's handling of immigration among adults.
 - 60% of voters feel like they hear more from Republicans than Democrats or President Biden on the issue of immigration.


Asylum Seekers and Humanitarian Parolees Allowed into the United States 2021-2024




